Dear AquilaCares participant:

Since 2001, generous contributions from customers, like you, have helped AquilaCares disburse more than \$2 million in customer, employee and company funds to residents in need.

As you may have heard, Kansas City Power & Light is currently in the process of acquiring Aquila. Once the acquisition is approved, KCP&L will combine the AquilaCares fund with KCP&L's Dollar-Aide, a low-income assistance program established 26 years ago to assist eligible individuals and families pay their utility bills and avoid loss of service. Merging the programs will help with fund administration and focus our efforts.

Although the AquilaCares name will change, there are many things that will remain the same.

- Both funds are fuel funds that collect donations to aid people in need of utility assistance.
- Customers' donations will support the same area agencies that AquilaCares supports.
- The Mid-America Assistance Coalition (MAAC) and the Greater United Way of St. Joseph will continue to administer funds to clients to help with their utility bills, including electric, water and gas, or other heating source; verify eligibility and approve payments.
- All donations will be tax deductible.

KCP&L will match every dollar donated with a 50-cent energy credit. Since its inception, KCP&L employees and customers have given more than \$3.4 million. In 2007, donations assisted 5,710 individuals, including 2,779 children and 351 senior citizens.

We hope you continue supporting this worthy cause that is improving the lives of thousands.
